



Avalanche Social Studies Retake Policy & Contract

Each quarter, Avalanche social studies students have the opportunity to revise or retake ONE assessment, excluding the last assessment of the quarter. The retake is a new and different assessment on the same material. Students who do the retake receive an entirely new score for that assessment, regardless of whether or not the new score is lower than the score on the original assessment.

In order to do so, these steps need to be followed:

1. Student must complete the revision/retake form below and return it to Mrs. Friel by the due date posted in the classroom and/or Weebly.
2. Original assessment must be attached to this form.
3. Evidence of study must also be presented to your teacher on the retake day (examples of proof of study – flash cards, highlighted notes, signed parent note of time spent studying, notes/ corrections on original assessment, etc.)
4. Student must stay at the specified time, which is either before after school, on the designated retake day(s).

It is your responsibility to know this policy, follow all procedures, and personally seek out your teacher if you want to retake an assessment.

All directions above must be followed for a retake to be allowed.
